The book corner is full of lovely books that I can read. I can play with the puppet theatre too.



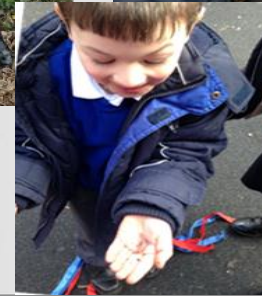
I can also choose to learn outside! Things are different out here. There's a climbing frame, bikes, and scooters.

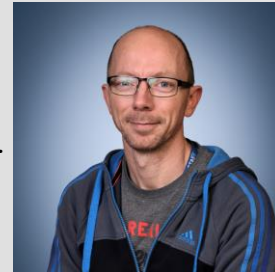

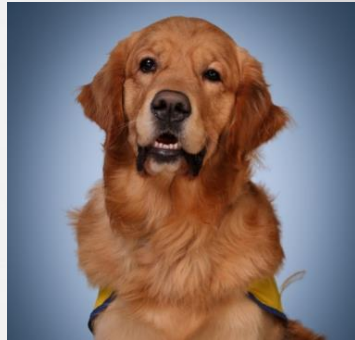
