



SHOULD I KEEP MY CHILD OFF SCHOOL?

Yes, until...

- Chicken Pox (until all blisters have crusted over)
- Vomiting or Diarrhoea Bug (return 48 hours from last episode)
- Flu Like Temperature (until they no longer have a high temperature)
- Impetigo (until their sores have crusted and healed or 48 hours after they started antibiotics)
- Measles (4 days after the rash first appeared)
- Mumps (5 days after the swelling started)
- Scabies (until they've had their first treatment)
- Scarlet Fever (24 hours after they started taking antibiotics)
- Whooping Cough (48 hours after they started taking antibiotics)

No, but inform your child's class teacher of:

- Cough
- Sore Throat (keep off school if accompanied with a high temperature)
- Earache
- Head lice
- Hand Foot and Mouth
- Threadworms
- Glandular Fever
- Slapped Cheek
- Tonsillitis
- Conjunctivitis
- Cold sores
- Isolated incident of sickness or diarrhoea (that you don't believe is part of a bug, e.g. indigestion or following coughing, one loose movement etc).
